## RESOLUTION #2025-135 OF THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION

## APPROVING THE INCREASE IN COMPENSATION AND SALARY FOR THE BALDWIN COUNTY BOARD OF REGISTRARS, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT NO. 2025-22.

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Baldwin County Board of Registrars effectively manage voter registration of the citizens of Balwin County, providing a valuable service to the citizens of Baldwin County, Alabama; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Baldwin County Board of Registrars currently receive a salary of one hundred twenty dollars (\$120) per day, with the State paying eighty dollars (\$80) per day, and the Baldwin County Commission paying a supplemental salary of forty dollars (\$40) per day; and

WHEREAS, Act Number 2025-22 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2025 legislative session amends, among other sections, Section 17-3-5 of the Code of Alabama 1975, as follows: "(a) Each registrar shall receive a salary in the amount of one hundred fifteen dollars (\$115) per day for each day's attendance upon business of the board, to be paid by the state and disbursed to the county commissions and disbursed by the county commissions to each registrar on order of a quorum of the board of registrars of the county;" and

**WHEREAS**, the increase in compensation for registrars as provided by Act Number 2025-22 is fully funded by the state with no increase in cost to the Baldwin County Commission; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED**, that the Baldwin County Commission hereby approves the salary increase for the members of the Baldwin County Board of Registrars, as authorized by Act No. 2025-22, from one hundred twenty dollars (\$120) per day, to one hundred fifty-five dollars (\$155) per day, with the state paying one hundred fifteen dollars (\$115) per day, and the Baldwin County Commission paying forty dollars (\$40) per day for each day's attendance upon business of the board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that said pay increase as mandated by Act No. 2025-22 shall become effective on October 1, 2025.
