Prodisee Pantry is counted upon by the Baldwin County Commission and local communities for food and resource management, along with distribution assistance at Points of Distribution following large natural and manmade disasters. For 23 years, Prodisee Pantry has been a trusted nonprofit supplying food to Baldwin County's food insecure and responding in times of need, including following Hurricanes, Flooding, the Gulf Oil Spill, Economic Crises, and the Covid-19 Pandemic. This longstanding record of service and accountability underscores our confidence in the organization's capacity to deliver on this project's mission.

For these reasons, the Baldwin County Commission offers our full endorsement and support for the Prodisee Pantry North project.
