DETERMINATION OF THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, REGARDING **CASE No. Z25-50, Danley Property** SUCH DETERMINATION AS AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO SECTION 45-2-261 THROUGH SECTION 45-2-261.18, CODE OF ALABAMA (1975).

**WHEREAS**, Baldwin County Planning and Zoning Department has petitioned the Baldwin County Commission, on behalf of Darrell Danley to rezone certain property, in Planning (Zoning) District No. 22, for property identified herein and described as follows:

LOT 2, Bryars Subdivision, according to map or plat thereof recorded on Slide 2995-D, in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Baldwin County, Alabama

Otherwise known as tax parcel number, **05-53-01-01-0-000-012.003** as found in the office of the Revenue Commissioner of Baldwin County, Alabama; and


**WHEREAS**, the petitioner has requested that 8.21+/- acres be rezoned from RA, Rural Agricultural District, to RSF-E, Residential Single Family Estate District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Baldwin County Commission held a public hearing on November 18, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the requirements of SECTION 45-2-261 THROUGH SECTION 45-2-261.18, CODE OF ALABAMA (1975), regarding procedures to consider this rezoning request, which would affect the Planning (Zoning) District Boundary designations of the Planning (Zoning) District No. 22 Official Map, have been met; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED**, that the petitioner's request to rezone 8.21+/- acres (Case No. Z25-50, Danley Property) as herein identified and described and as found within the confines of Planning (Zoning) District No. 22 from RA, Rural Agricultural District, to RSF-E, Residential Single Family Estate District, which amends the Planning (Zoning) District Boundary designations of the Planning (Zoning) District No. 22 Official Map, is hereby **APPROVED**.
