

## Request to Initiate Zoning Proposal for the Stockton/Landmark District


Dear Baldwin County Commission,

I am writing on behalf of a group of concerned residents to formally request that the Baldwin County Commission initiate the process to form a new zoning district for the area described below.

We believe that implementing zoning in this area is necessary to protect our property, our community, and our environment.

Proposed District Location: Properties that fall in and around the Landmark District. Beginning at the point where interstate 65 intersects the line dividing Range 2 East (R2E) and Range 3 East (R3E); thence, north along said R2E/R3E line to its intersection with Rains Creek; thence, easterly following the meanders of Rains Creek to its intersection with Lighter Knott Creek; thence, northerly following the meanders of Lighter Knott Creek to its terminus; thence, due North to its intersection with Aikin Creek; thence, westerly following the meanders of Aikin Creek to its intersection with the R2E/R3E line; thence, north along the R2E/R3E line to Little Halls Creek; thence, westerly following the meanders of Little Halls Creek to Halls Creek; thence, generally southwesterly following the meanders of Halls Creek to Tensaw Lake; thence, southerly following the meanders of Tensaw Lake to the Tensaw River; thence, southerly following the meanders of the Tensaw River to Interstate 65; thence, generally east/northeast along Interstate 65 to the Point of the Beginning.
