**RESOLUTION #2026-013

BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION**

**RESOLUTION ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS USING
AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, Baldwin County, Alabama, (the “County”) has received American Rescue Plan Act State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (“ARPA funds”); and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission (the “Commission”) is charged with ensuring that such funds are expended in accordance with state and federal law; and

WHEREAS, ARPA funds may be used to cover the cost of expenses for necessary investments in water infrastructure projects and improvements to ventilation systems in public facilities as eligible uses of ARPA funds; and

WHEREAS, the Commission awarded Project No. HW21102000 - Pave County Road 65 from County Road 24 to County Road 28 to the lowest bidder, Mobile Asphalt Company, LLC, in the Bid Amount \$1,019,403.12, on October 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Commission awarded Project No. HW22130 - River Road Drainage Improvements to the lowest bidder, Murphree Bridge Corporation, in the Base Bid Amount \$2,067,033.96 plus Bid Additive 1 Amount \$98,014.00 for a total of \$2,165,047.96 on October 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of the Treasury released the updated guidance on the reobligation of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds on November 9, 2023. If a project funded by the ARPA SLFRF is completed with total project expenditures less than the approved budgeted obligation, the remaining funds can be reallocated to other eligible projects that were obligated by the December 31, 2024, reporting deadline; and

WHEREAS, the Commission received Change Order #1 in the amount of \$162,348.80 for Project No. HW22130 - River Road Drainage Improvements with Murphree Bridge Corporation on October 9, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Commission closed out Project No. HW21102000 - Paving of County Road 65 from County Road 24 to County Road 28, following its completion on October 8, 2025, resulting in a remaining balance of \$99,142.88 in unspent ARPA funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

1) The Commission hereby deallocates \$95,465.30 in ARPA funds for Project No. HW21102000 - Pave County Road 65 from County Road 24 to County Road 28 Project.

2) The Commission hereby reallocated \$95,465.30 in ARPA funds for Project No. HW22130 - River Road Drainage Improvements Project.

3) The County Administrator is hereby authorized to expend the ARPA funds described herein to cover costs that are reasonably necessary for the completion of the project and subject to the limitations set forth herein.

4) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Resolution to the contrary, expenditure of the funds for the purposes described herein for costs associated with the project shall be contingent on compliance with applicable state and federal laws related to competitive procurement of goods and services.

5) The allocations and expenditure of ARPA funds for the purposes described herein shall be contingent on the continued appropriation and availability of ARPA funds for this purpose, and in no event shall be used for any expenses not expended by December 31, 2026.
