The Baldwin County Commission met for a work session (pre-Commission meeting) on August 6, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. in the Baldwin County Administration Building, County Commission Meeting Chambers.

WELCOME, INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Following the Invocation by Pastor Joe Aldrete, Executive Director and Senior Pastor of The Dream Center of Baldwin County, the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Gruber.

Pastor Aldrete thanked the Commission for their support of The Dream Center through the distribution of the tobacco tax.

REVIEW OF ITEMS AND SETTING OF THE CONSENT AGENDA

Review and discussion of items on the Regular meeting agenda. The Commission will set the Consent Agenda for the Regular meeting, determining the order of items for consideration with any additions, removals and/or replacements as presented.

CA1 - Discussion took place regarding the need for two additional Assistants to the

Absentee Election Manager for the November 2024 General Election and the office location for absentee voting.

It was decided contracts for two additional Assistants to the Absentee Election Manager would be added to the August 20, 2024, Regular meeting for Commission approval.

<u>CA2</u> - The updated Certificate of Liability insurance has been received from the event organizer.

<u>CA8</u> - Discussion took place regarding the boundary lines of the Propst Cemetery not meeting the current setback requirements. It was decided the existing burial plots would be grandfathered in.

<u>CA9</u> - Discussion took place regarding Commission Policy #2.7 pertaining to establishing private cemeteries requiring a site visit by the Commissioner in the district. It was decided an agenda item would be brought forward to the August 20, 2024, Regular meeting to modify the policy by removing any unnecessary requirements.

Commissioner Ball noted the motion made for Item CA8 should include that the existing burial plots be grandfathered in.

<u>CL1</u> - Terri Graham, CEO of the Solid Waste Disposal Authority of Baldwin County (SWDA), discussed the Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, all 14 municipalities being on the plan unless they opt out, and the timeline including a draft of the plan brought before the Commission in December before submission to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, and a public hearing in January with the final plan being approved in early February 2025.

Ms. Graham noted the tentative date for opening the Landfill Gas Recovery Plant is in the beginning of 2025 and the Materials Recovery Facility being the end of November.

<u>CO7</u> - Chairman Underwood asked that Item CO7 be moved to Other Staff Recommendations for a separate vote due to a potential conflict of interest.

<u>CS1</u> - Chairman Underwood noted correspondence was received from Mr. Danny Bolton, resigning from the Planning and Zoning Commission, and asked that accepting Mr. Bolton's resignation be added to Item CS1.

GENERAL

1 Proposal to Install Memorial Benches at Baldwin County Bicentennial Park 24-0939

Ms. Kelly Stewart addressed the Commission on behalf of Claudia Campbell, Chairperson of America 250 for the Fort Mims Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, regarding the proposal to install a memorial bench at Baldwin County Bicentennial Park's Veterans Memorial in commemoration of the Nation's 250th birthday on July 4, 2026.

Chairman Underwood noted the Commission is developing a master plan for Bicentennial Park and the placement of the bench would be incorporated into the plan.

Mr. Donald F. Potter, Jr., President of the General Galvez Chapter of the Alabama Society of the Sons of the American Revolution (ALSSAR), read a prepared statement regarding the purpose and significance of the bench honoring the sacrifices and service of those who have defended the Nation.

Chairman Underwood noted the placement and dedication ceremony may need to be delayed due to the master plan for Bicentennial Park being developed.
