Hey Wayne, while you're working on the documents, we still haven't discussed exactly what I can do, so I thought I would type it out here and you can let me know what you think. And can you give me the address to the Bicentennial Park you're talking about? The only one I'm seeing is 15 miles away - address 51233 AL-225, Stockton, AL 36579 - that's a little far away, but we can make it work. I just need to make sure that's the park you're referring to.

Here's my ideal event...

I would like to do 2 back to back events on both Friday and Saturday (Friday, November 12th & Saturday, November 13th)

- Maximum of 50 people per event
- Fans would check in at Bicentennial Park at NOON
- Everyone would hang out, play games, cookout, set up their tents, etc at the park until around 4pm
- It will get completely dark on those days at 5:30pm. So around 4:30pm everyone can drive/car-pull to Byrnes Lake Landing for the movie screening
- Movie runs about 1 hr 30 mins
- Around 7pm everyone will head back to the park. I'll probably set up another small movie screen to watch a couple more movies. Maybe make a fire and roast smores.
- Everyone will check out at 10am the next day.
- Then repeat that for Saturday, check out at 10am on Sunday
- And this would be the formula for the following years if I can make this an annual event.
