Stapleton School would like to request the assistance of the Baldwin County Highway Department in repainting the red, white, and blue center line that covers the block which includes the school (composed of Baldwin Avenue and Ryland Street). The stripes were originally painted in 2002 to commemorate the first anniversary of 9/11. It's been several years since the stripes were repainted and they have become faded and worn.

Our school is making plans to celebrate our country's 250th birthday next school year and the twenty-fifth anniversary of the 9/11 attacks will take place in 2026 as well. We would love to have patriotic stripes back in great shape for the important anniversaries that are coming up and would be very grateful for the Highway Department's help.

**NOTE**: We received the quote for \$1666.09 to cover material and labor costs, and we agree to cover those expenses. A couple of requests: 1) Would it be possible to pay for the materials as a reimbursement to the Department along with the labor costs as we do not have any sort of business relationship with the vendors who sell those items? 2) Also, we are planning to have our students raise these funds as a patriotic service project so would like for the work to happen after the funds have been raised. Will it be possible to delay the work while our students work to raise the funds?
