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Good Morning Michelle,

I hope this email finds you well. You were my contact for last year's parade, please let me know if you are still available to help with this again. If not please let me know who to contact. It's the same set up as last year, here are the details.....

On Sunday, February 15th, 2026, Fort Morgan will conduct our 7th Annual Mardi Gras Parade, beginning at 1pm. The parade route is 1.9 miles and will take about 1 1/2 hours. It will require closing Ponce de Leon for the parade route, Triple Tail Lane, which will be closed for staging, and Bernard Ct East, which will be used for exiting. As in the past, I will be contacting the Fort Morgan Volunteer Fire Department to assist in traffic control and safety for the duration of the parade, and closure from noon to 2:30 pm. I have attached a copy of the parade route, and the insurance policy, which names both BCC and BCSO as insured parties.
