Re: Food Permit Exclusion

This letter is to confirm that the music event on November 30th sponsored by Eric Arellano does not currently require a temporary food service permit from the Alabama Department of Public Health. Based on the State Board of Health, Food Sanitation Rules, a temporary food service permit is not required for an event that does not prepare or serve any unpackaged food or drink, or one that does not reuse repeat use utensils and tableware.

The items below are suggested food safety practices that you should use:

- Refrigeration units shall be maintained at 41°F or below.
- Practice frequent handwashing and maintain a high level of personal hygiene.
- Garbage shall be disposed of appropriately and in a sanitary manner.
- Keep toxic items and all medications away from food preparation areas.
- Use only commercially processed and store-bought foods for service.
- Overhead protection, such as umbrella or tent.
