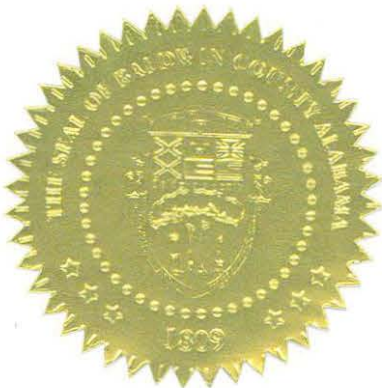
WHEREAS, the mental health and well-being of children are essential to their success in school, relationships, and throughout life; and

WHEREAS, early identification and intervention for children experiencing mental health challenges can lead to significantly improved outcomes in emotional, social, and academic development; and


