County Priority Infrastructure – CR-65 Extension Phase 2

Program Summary

The County Priority Infrastructure Program (CPIP) will provide CDBG-DR funding to develop segments of the CR-65 corridor to increase capacity, safety, and the region's economic competitiveness. The County Rd 65 corridor project will increase current transportation capacity and improve public safety by providing better lighting, widening of roadway, paving shoulders, and installing new centerlines & shoulder rumble strips.

The Highway Department will use CDBG-DR dollars for construction of .05 new miles of roadway between CR-34 and CR-36. The construction of this roadway supplements the extension of CR-65 between CR-28 and CR-32, which was previously approved by the Commission and submitted for approval to ADECA.

CR-65 is a hurricane evacuation route for the County and can be classified as critical infrastructure. This project will improve roadway resiliency within the county and will also address redundancy, strengthening north-south routes in the area. The new segments of CR-65 will be constructed to expand roadway capacity and interconnect municipalities including Gulf Shores, Foley, Magnolia Springs, Summerdale, Robertsdale, and unincorporated communities within Baldwin County.

The submitted Activity Profile Form is for Phase 2 of the program and only provides details pertaining to the .05 miles of new highway between CR-34 and CR-36.
