RESOLUTION 2006-133

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Commission (the County) previously voted, on March 2nd, 2006, unanimously in favor of Resolution 2006-72 and thereby transferring the maintenance of County Road 4 West and County Road 6 West, along with other local roads as specified therein, to the City of Gulf Shores (the City) for a cost of \$116,000.00 and a final resurfacing (1 inch overlay) at a later date with a six month notice from the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City subsequently requested, via letter dated May 24, 2006, that the agreement between the City and the County be altered to reflect certain changes; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City reiterated those requested changes during the July 10, 2006 Road and Bridge Divisional Meeting; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, that as requested by the City of Gulf Shores, the County's Agreement, the terms of which are contained within County Resolution 2006-72, with the City is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) All provisions of the County's Resolution 2006-72 shall remain in effect unless specifically addressed by this document.
- 2) The City will retain the \$116,000.00 for maintenance of County Road 4 West and will repair and overlay the first mile of that road extending generally from Highway 59 to the new Waterdance Developments.
- 3) The County will pay the costs of materials for a one-inch overlay (125 lb/sy), for the entire CR4 West/CR 6 West Loop, within six (6) months of a request to do so.
- 4) The City will, upon the execution of this Resolution, accept control and maintenance responsibility of CR 4 West, to include the short extension of CR 6 West which runs Westward from the end of CR 4 West including the Plash Island Bridge, and:

- 5) At the time that all properties adjacent to both sides of CR6 West are annexed into the City's corporate limits, the City will immediately assume control and maintenance responsibilities of such roadway.
