Hope everything is going good in your world.

We spoke a few weeks ago about a proposed full access/ Signalized intersection at the FBE and CR 8. As you know, this would require a variance from the Tri Party Agreement AMP that BCBC is a part of. You had requested a couple of pieces of information, which I have attached for you to review. I plan on meeting with the City of Foley this week to discuss the Variance with them as well. The County Commission would also have to approve the variance but would only do so if BCBC and Foley support the variance. It is my understanding that the City is in support of this and I hope to get a letter from them very soon.

Please let me know what your thoughts are and a time frame of when I may hear something back from BCBC. I am trying to get this in front of the County Commission this month for a vote.
