RE: County Noise Ordinance

Hi Mr. Davis,

My wife and I both live in your district in the Sedona Subdivision in Daphne (23737 Havasu Drive). Several nights throughout the week, we hear extremely loud music, gun shots, yelling, and dirt bikes in the woods behind our subdivision (sometimes as late as 11pm-2am). This causes many restless nights and several mothers in our community have complained that their children can't sleep due to the high volume of the noise.

We, along with many of our neighbors, have contacted the Baldwin County Sheriff's office for assistance with this matter. The deputies have informed us several times that there is currently no county noise ordinance for those outside of the city limits and that there is nothing that they can do about it. It has been frustrating for us and others to hear VERY loud noises inside our homes late at night without any recourse of getting it stopped.

I am contacting your office to see if there is any type of noise ordinance legislation that could be put forth by the Commission, especially for those outside of the city limits. Given Baldwin County's rapid growth over the last few years, I believe it would greatly benefit our area to have a county-wide nuisance law in place to detract from these types of noise disturbances.

In my opinion, Baldwin County needs to adopt a nuisance law to prohibit these type of situations during certain hours of the day. Some of the largest counties in Alabama have already adopted these noise laws for outside of the city limits (Montgomery, Madison, Shelby, Jefferson, etc).

I appreciate your consideration in this matter and I look forward to hearing back from you.
