## **PROCLAMATION**

## PROCLAIMING MAY 7-13, 2023, AS NATIONAL CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS WEEK IN BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA.

WHEREAS, on May 5, 1984, Ronald Reagan, the 40<sup>th</sup> President of the United States, delivered a proclamation designating the first week in May as National Correctional Officers Week; and

WHEREAS, the staff members who serve in the position of Correctional Officers, whether civilian or security staff, are essential to the day-to-day operations of the Baldwin County Sheriff's Office Corrections Center; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has recognized the essential services provided by all Correctional Officers in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Sheriff's Office employs approximately 140 Correctional Officers; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Sheriff's Office Correctional Officers oversee the safety and security of approximately 600 inmates on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Sheriff's Office Corrections Center processes approximately 13,000 inmates being booked in or booked out of the Baldwin County Sheriff's Office Corrections Center on an annual basis; now therefore

BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED that the week of May 7-13, 2023, is hereby designated as National Correctional Officers Week in Baldwin County, Alabama.
