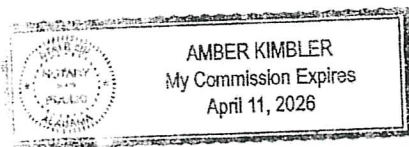

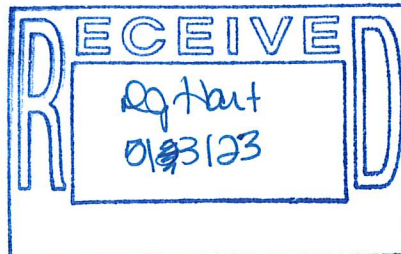

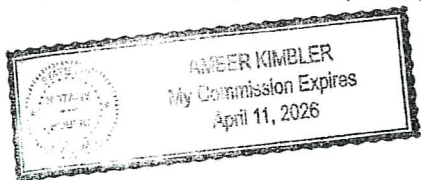

DAY MINETTE — Twelve seniors at Baldwin County High School have answered the call for a career in education as part of the Future Teachers Signing Day.

The signing ceremony was held in the school's library. Taking part included Future Teachers of Alabama members Tre Kerria Smith, Riera Means, Ashlyn Latham, Analee Barnett and Allison Smith, Coastal Alabama Community College; Malaysia Andrews, Auburn University at Montgomery; Leslie Odum, Jacksonville State University; Brianna Broadus and Mallory Hastings, Troy University; Ella Stapleton, Bishop State Community College; Alex Wasdon, Huntington College; and Mason Smith, University of South Alabama.

As part of the ceremony, each student shared their college and career plans as well as their motivation to become a teacher. Many cited the desire to make a positive influence on stu-

dents as their driving force, the impact teachers had made on their own lives, and to help students excel to their full potential. Their career paths were also varied with many headed into elementary education, some to the secondary level and one shared plans to become a college professor.

Future Teachers of Alabama is an organization within the Aspiring Educators/Student Division of the Alabama Education Association (AEA). It is for middle and high school students who have expressed an interest in the field of education as a career choice. The purpose of holding the Future Teachers' Signing Day is to build statewide excitement about reducing the teacher shortage in Alabama and celebrating the seniors who are ready to take on the challenge of educating future students.

The program was implemented at UCHS two years ago. In addition to taking part in job shadowing of educators, the members also take part in various service

projects including a book drive to benefit elementary schools in the feeder pattern and will soon collect items for tornado victims in Hollingsfork, Miss. Chapter sponsors include Chantelle McPherson, Misty Mayes Byrd, Vickie Locke and Dona Davis.

In her remarks, Chapter Sponsor Chantelle McPherson thanked the students for answering the call "that is bigger than you" and quoted Nelson Mandela in that education is the most powerful weapon you can use to change the world. She challenged these future teachers to propel their students into arenas beyond their own imagination, "Future teacher, teach because you love children. Teach because you love to see them dream. Teach because you know if your student is awoken to win they truly are, they are unstoppable. Teach because your impact is infinite. Teach because our children need you. Teach because you have been called for such a time as this."

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
