WHEREAS, Baldwin County in Compliance with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, is required to address the subject of ensuring that Baldwin County services and facilities are accessible to those with disabilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Baldwin County Commission, as follows:

The Baldwin County Commission approves the amended *Public Right of Way Barrier Analysis and Transition Plan* in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA).

The County Administrator, in his capacity, will serve as the ADA Compliance Officer and is authorized to revise and update the plan as necessary. The final plan must be approved by the Commission.
