
MISSION STATEMENT



NARCOTICS

- TRENDS:
- ICE METHAMPHETAMINES CONTINUES TO BE IN THE TOP THREE DRUG ISSUES IN THE COUNTY. STAYING CONSISTENT WITH LAST YEAR THE PURITY LEVELS ARE HIGH AND PRICES CONTINUE TO FALL. THE FALL IN PRICE IS HAVING A DIRECT EFFECT ON OUR SEIZURE LEVELS. WE ARE SEEING MORE INDIVIDUALS BRINGING IN LARGER QUANTITIES AT A TIME. WE SAW AN INCREASE OF 745 %. THE ATLANTA, GA AND PENSACOLA, FL ARE THE TWO MAIN SOURCES OF SUPPLY.
- CLANDESTINE LAB OPERATIONS CONTINUES TO DROP. WE ONLY SEIZED 3 LABS THE PAST YEAR.
- HEROIN / FENTANYL CONTINUES TO BE ON THE RISE IN THE COUNTY. IT IS CONTRIBUTING TO A DRAMATIC INCREASE IN OVERDOSES. WE SAW OVER A 3800%
 INCREASE IN SEIZURES THIS PAST YEAR. THE LARGE QUANTITIES OF HEROIN SEEM TO BE COMING FROM BIRMINGHAM, AL. WE ALSO HAVE QUANTITIES
 COMING FROM THE PENSACOLA AREA WHICH IS ALSO WHERE WE ARE SEEING FENTANYL. THIS DRUG IS QUICKLY OVERTAKING THE AREA.
- COCAINE DECREASED THIS YEAR BY 38%. PRICES ARE STILL LOW AND PREVALENT THROUGHOUT THE MUNICIPAL AREAS OF THE COUNTY.
- PRESCRIPTION PILLS ARE STILL ON A DECLINE OF 14%. THIS CAN BE ATTRIBUTED TO PAIN MANAGEMENT DOCTORS BEING PROSECUTED AND THE ABUNDANCE OF HEROIN IN THE AREA.
- MARIJUANA SAW A 66% INCREASE. WE ARE STILL SEEING HIGH GRADE MARIJUANA COMING IN OVER THE INTERSTATE OR THROUGH PARCEL PACKAGES.
 MAINLY COMING FROM STATES THAT HAVE LEGALIZED IT.


