Dear Skip:

Thank you for taking the time to speak with me this morning about the town's issue with the "vintage" culvert pipes running north on Main Street along the ROW fronting the Centennial and Regions Bank properties. Per a meeting with ALDOT this morning, they will be replacing the old culvert piping under U.S. Hwy. 98 in the next few weeks. Since the piping that runs north of U.S. Hwy. 98 appears to be of the same era, it is assumed that it will also need replacing sooner rather than later since sink holes are beginning to appear.

The following are estimated calculations of the 18" +/- piping distance from the junction boxes just north of U.S. Hwy. 98 to the terminus for each side:

West side	Centennial Bank	112' +/-
East side	Regions Bank	165' +/-

Any assistance that the County could provide is greatly appreciated by the Town Council and citizens of Elberta.
