

RESOLUTION NO. 008-19

AUTHORIZING AND CONSENTING TO THE TRANSFER OF
OWNERSHIP, MAINTENANCE, AND RESPONSIBILITY
FOR STYRON LANE
FROM BALDWIN COUNTY TO THE CITY OF ROBERTSDALE

WHEREAS, a certain Styron Lane, which is approximately 0.25 miles in length (hereinafter "Styron Lane"), is contiguous with the corporate limits of the City of Robertsdale; and

WHEREAS, the City of Robertsdale desires to take over sole and exclusive ownership, control, management, supervision, regulation, repair, maintenance, improvement, and responsibility for Styron Lane to facilitate access and the development of property owned by the City of Robertsdale in this area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Robertsdale has found and determined that taking over sole and exclusive ownership, control, management, supervision, regulation, repair, maintenance, improvement, and responsibility of Styron Lane in the best interest of the City of Robertsdale; and

WHEREAS, the City of Robertsdale has the legal authority to carry out the intent of this resolution pursuant to Code of Alabama, Section 11-49-80 and other state laws and constitutional amendments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Robertsdale, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Robertsdale hereby agrees to accept and take over from Baldwin County the sole and exclusive ownership, control, management, supervision, regulation, repair, maintenance, improvement, and responsibility of Styron Lane, being approximately 0.25 miles south of U.S. Highway 90.

Section 2. That the Mayor, City Clerk, and other City officials are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such documents or agreements to Baldwin County as are necessary or requested to carry out the intent of this Resolution.


