RESOLUTION #2020-024 OF THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION

REMOVING THE MONETARY LIMITATION ON COMPENSATION FOR SUPERNUMERARY TAX COLLECTORS, TAX ASSESSORS, LICENSE COMMISSIONERS, ETC, IN BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 40-6-3, OF THE <u>CODE OF</u> ALABAMA (1975).

WHEREAS, every supernumerary official shall serve for life and shall receive from the county governing body, in equal monthly installments on the first of each month, or in such installments as other county officials or employees are paid, an annual salary based on the years of service; and

WHEREAS, Code Section 40-6-3 states no person shall receive more than forty-nine thousand six hundred dollars (\$49,600) per year; and

WHEREAS, Code Section 40-6-3 states the county governing body may, by majority vote of the membership, elect to increase or remove this monetary limitation on compensation for any person who assumed supernumerary status after September 30, 1993; and

COMES NOW, this honorable county governing body, pursuant to the authority as set forth by Section 40-6-3, of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975), desiring to remove the monetary limitation of \$49,600 for supernumerary tax collectors, tax assessors, license commissioners, etc.; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that this honorable county governing body, pursuant to the authority as set forth by the aforementioned law, hereby removes the monetary limitation of \$49,600 for supernumerary tax collectors, tax assessors, license commissioners, etc., effective November 5, 2019.
