In light of the Governor's postponement of the Primary Runoff Election until July 14th and the revised election calendar extending absentee voting in accordance therewith, I respectfully request that Evelina Hernandez and I receive our normal daily rate of pay for performing our absentee voting duties for as many days as we perform them extending beyond the original Primary Runoff Election day plus the 7 days after the original election date which would have been April 7, 2020. If the new date of July 14, 2020, is not shortened or absentee voting is not shortened, then I respectfully request that we be paid for actual days worked on absentee duties through 7 days after the new primary runoff election date which is July 21, 2020.
