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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Baldwin County; providing for an
4 additional expense allowance and salary for the Baldwin County
5 Revenue Commissioner.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Commencing on the first day of the month
8 immediately following the effective date of this act, the
9 Revenue Commissioner of Baldwin County shall be entitled to an
10 additional expense allowance in the amount of twenty thousand
11 dollars (\$20,000) per annum, which shall be in addition to all
12 other expense allowances, compensation, or salary provided by
13 law. This expense allowance shall be payable in equal monthly
14 installments from the general fund of the county.

15 Section 2. Beginning with the expiration of the term
16 of the incumbent revenue commissioner, the annual salary for
17 the revenue commissioner shall be increased by twenty thousand
18 dollars (\$20,000) per annum, payable in equal monthly
19 installments from the general fund of the county and at that
20 time, Section 1 shall be come null and void.

21 Section 3. This act shall become effective
22 immediately following its passage and approval by the
23 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
