I am so excited to announce that the Ft Mims Restoration Association has unanimously voted to proceed with plans for the 2021 Reenactment and Living History event at Ft Mims! The dates will be, as always, the last full weekend in August—This year August 28 & 29th, 9a-3p. Reenactors from all across the Southeast are already making plans to make this a wonderful year, especially since the Covid Pandemic closed down this and most every other event in 2020. The two Hurricanes last Fall dealt Ft Mims with heavy damage. The new clear cut property just north of the site allowed the high east winds to blow freely and we lost 20-25 huge trees, mostly pines. When Zeta came along, the winds came from the south and large trees again fell into the stockade at Ft Mims, but from the opposite direction that time. Months later, thanks to the Parks Department, things are looking good again!

I would like to request assistance from the County Commission with the continued preparation of the site, mosquito control, 30 large rolling garbage cans, painting of the parking area, and 4 Handicapped Portolets (that need to be emptied on Saturday evening after 4). I would appreciate any assistance your office may be able to give, too, with the many needs that arise during this type event!

Please let all of the County Commissioners know that we hope they will mark their calendars and attend this amazing historic reenactment here in Tensaw! FMRA thanks them in advance for all their support!!
