



As an educational program for students and local residents, the app will allow for self-guided learning to accommodate a variety of educational and physical capabilities. This app will also teach users to appreciate and better care for the natural resources available in Baldwin County.

The tourism aspect of the app allows for heavy promotion from Baldwin County's Chambers of Commerce and visitors bureaus with information that can easily be replicated for Mobile and Escambia agencies.

The director of the Fort Mims Historic Site, the director of the Fort Morgan Historic Site and the Director of the Historic Blakeley State park committed to partnering with Baldwin County for the development and promotion of the app. Local municipalities has committed to assist in the promotion of the app as well on their social media, website, electronic billboard and newsletters.

The Baldwin County Commission has its own avenues for promotion, including press releases, information at the county offices and promotion on the county's television airing of the Commission meetings. The app will be fully promoted via all available avenues.



Community Development

As a community development tool, this app will enhance the tourism offerings in Baldwin County, which leads to further economic development of the County.

This app will offer students, residents and visitors alike a user friendly, customizable and affordable way to take advantage of the County's natural resources as they gain a better insight into its history.



What Geographic area will be served by this project? This app will eventually encompass all areas of Baldwin County, and as mentioned earlier, have a county-wide impact. There is an option for everyone of any ability to enjoy. With this app, Users can visit sites and listen to the guided tour at their own pace while still receiving the same in-depth experience as everyone else. Users can choose their own topic of interest. Visitors can follow along from their vehicles-which will allow for the County's senior population to access the various historic sites as well. The tour is available to the public from the actual sites or virtually.

Support Value Added

The Baldwin County Commission is the lead agency on the project, with multiple departments and external sources working on the app.

The Archives Department compiled the historic data and work on the narration portion and verified photographs.

The CIS department and the Director of Public and Government Affairs worked on the technical side of the app development, including the mapping and georeferencing of the sites.

The project is a GPS enabled user-friendly self-guided tour app for mobile phones or tablets. The project is a way for us to enhance the stories of our county through text, audio, georeferenced interactive maps, images, and video.

In short, through this app, we are connecting people, places and telling Baldwin County's Story!

Primary Functions of the App:



The Baldwin Tours App opens a door to the past! With background on key historic sites, Visitors can explore on foot or by car as they listen to exclusive audio about historic sites with a rich past spanning many decades. Other app features includes interactive maps of the historic site to help visitors explore the venue and tell its story.



GPS to create a custom experience for visitors depending on their location.




Photos, videos, audio, text, interactive images and other opportunities to interact with the exhibits.
