



Through the Wish Discovery process, the team talks to the children about their interests and help about their anciests and help figure out what they want their wish to be. McIntosh's wish for a camper is an ex-ample of a unique wish. They have also had one child wish

for braces for her teeth and two wishes for college tuitton for a year.

The average cost of one wish is between \$8,000 to \$10,000 so fundraising and community events are essential. Each year, Make-Awish of Alabama hests tealas in Mobile, Birmingham and Huntsville aud the Trailblaze Challenge which raises over \$800,000 a year. Through a partnership with America's Thriff Store Make-A-Wish receives roughly 3 cents for every bag of unwanted items are donated. "It doesn't sound like a lot, but it equates to almost \$1 million a year. If you are not able to donate 200 or \$100, we encourage you to donate your cutused items to America's Thriff Store because that helps us grant wishes and
