RESOLUTION

COMMENDING JUDGE JULIAN B. "BUDDY" BRACKIN, JR., FOR 31 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF ORANGE BEACH AND HIS YEARS OF DISTINGUISHED PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Judge Julian B. "Buddy" Brackin, Jr., grew up in Faunsdale, Alabama, in Marengo County, and was a graduate of Thomaston High School in 1968, attended the Marion Military Institute and graduated from Troy University in 1972; and

WHEREAS, he thereafter attended the University of Alabama School of Law obtaining his Doctor of Jurisprudence in 1976, as well as his Master's Degree in Public Administration and was admitted to the Alabama Bar on September 29, 1976, and began employment with the Alabama Attorney General's Office; and

WHEREAS, he relocated to Baldwin County, Alabama, and in 1986, formed his law firm, Julian B. Brackin, P.C., which later became Brackin, McGriff and Johnson, P.C.; and

WHEREAS, in 1994 was named the second-ever Municipal Judge for the City of Orange Beach, after serving for three years as an acting judge, and continued to hold the official position for another 28 years, and has also served previously as the Municipal Judge for the Town of Elberta for 18 years and the Town of Summerdale for seven years and has continued to serve as Municipal Judge for the City of Robertsdale for 42 years; and

WHEREAS, it is an honor to extend highest commendations to Judge Brackin for serving on the judicial bench for 31 years for the City of Orange Beach; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, that the Baldwin County Commission commends and congratulates Municipal Judge Julian B. "Buddy" Brackin, Jr., on his 31 years of service to the City of Orange Beach and years of service across the municipalities of Baldwin County, Alabama, and this resolution hereby serves as a tribute to him with utmost gratitude and admiration, along with sincere best wishes for continued success and happiness during his retirement from the Municipal Judgeship of the City of Orange Beach; and
