Mr. Willard Holliman appeared before the Commission and discussed a problem with dividing property, unfair land practices and the December 29, 2020, Planning District 19 Election being held in the sanctuary of Bethel Lutheran Church.

Mr. Williams further discussed the December 29, 2020, Planning District 19 Election, complying with Federal Statutes, and Voting Precinct 10.

The Commission, Wayne Dyess, County Administrator and Brad Hicks, County Attorney, discussed the need for further discussion regarding the process going forward on the Planning District 19 Election, voting precincts, zoning referendums, citizens' rights to pursue zoning districts per the State Legislature, the Baldwin County Commission and Probate Judge serving in a limited role as a procedural function in verifying petitions, the County Commission not having the authority to make decisions on where the planning district elections take place, the law regarding planning district elections and clarification on planning districts and voting precincts.
