Commissioner Gruber; Cian Harrison, Clerk Treasurer; and Sherry-Lea Botop, Director of Public/Government Affairs, discussed the projects the County is submitting for GOMESA funding, Recycling Facility at the Magnolia Landfill, County Road 6 Boat Launch, and Regional Detention Ponds, and if they would be approved to be funded.

The Commissioners discussed the Magnolia Landfill Recycling Facility being a priority for the County and the possibility of the State not funding the project, funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) being available and the possibility of the funds to be allocated for the Landfill Recycling Facility project.

Further discussion followed by Suzanne Doughty, Accounting Manager; and Joey Nunnally, County Engineer, regarding transfer of ARPA funds to the Magnolia Landfill Recycling Facility project which would speed up the process, and the need for regional detention ponds in the County.

The Commissioners requested Mr. Nunnally to pursue GOMESA funding for the regional detention ponds.

Deidra Hanak, Personnel Director, discussed the Juneteenth Independence Day holiday and requested the Commission to consider adding the holiday to the Employee Handbook as a recognized paid holiday. Ms. Hanak requested the Commission to consider adding a one-time holiday change for the 2021 Christmas Holidays. The County's adopted policy recognizes Christmas Eve and Christmas Day as employee holidays. If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the holiday is observed on the preceding Friday; if a holiday falls on a Sunday, the holiday is observed on the following Monday. With Christmas Eve being on a Friday, staff requests the Commission consider the 2021 Christmas holiday be observed on Thursday, December 23, 2021 and Friday, December 24, 2021.

Commissioner Davis noted the Commission should coordinate the Christmas holiday closing with other agencies at the Courthouses.

It was decided Ms. Hanak will check with the State on its holiday schedule and bring the item back for discussion at the next meeting. The Commission decided to move forward with the Juneteenth Independence Day holiday approval to the regular meeting.
