Auditorium

The Board of Adjustment for Baldwin County Commission District 2 met in a regular session on September 14, 2020 at 4:08 p.m., in the Baldwin County Central Annex Auditorium. Chairman Brandon Bias called the meeting to order. Members present included: Michael Cochran and Mary Shannon Hope. Staff member present was Linda Lee, Planner.

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

A motion to approve the previous meeting minutes was made by Mr. Cochran with a second by Ms. Hope and carried unanimously.

V-200025, Stewart Property

Mrs. Lee presented the applicant's request for a variance from the front and rear yard setback requirements to allow for future development of the lot. Staff noted that the applicant did not request a variance from the jurisdictional wetlands on the property and any future development would require a wetlands setback variance. Staff recommended approval of the variance request with the following conditions:

- 1. Any roadside stairs would have to come off the east side or go under the house.
- 2. No deck or stairs will be allowed over the front setback line.
- 3. The air conditioning unit must be located within the 10-foot side setback.
- 4. Approval is for proposed buildable area of 36' x 40'.

Board Member Michael Cochran made a motion to approve the variance request subject to conditions listed by staff. The motion received a second from Board Member Mary Hope and carried unanimously.

New Business

Mrs. Lee reviewed the upcoming changes pertaining to the legislative act combining the Baldwin County Districts 1, 2 and 3 Boards of Adjustment into one new Board of Adjustment Number 1 and the usage allowance for alternate members.
