#### **Background:**

Franklin Primary Health Center, Inc. is a 501-C3, not-for-profit local and community health center established in 1975 by a group of concerned citizens. The Center is financed by Medicaid, Medicare and private insurance payments as well as federal, state and local contributions. Currently the center operates community based health centers in Mobile, Baldwin, Escambia, Monroe, Conecuh and

Choctaw Counties in Alabama and serve over 40,000 patients annually.

On July 18, 2019, staff received a request from Mr. Charles White, Chief Executive Officer of Franklin Primary Health Center, Inc., for the Baldwin County Commission to send a letter of support to Franklin Primary Health Center, Inc. for the Service Area Competition Application for the Public Health Service Section 330 grant.
