Adopt a Proclamation which proclaims the week of May 18-24, 2019 as "National Safe Boating Week" in Baldwin County, Alabama.

**Background:** National Safe Boating Week will be observed May 18-24, 2019.

### General Information:

For nearly 100 million Americans, boating continues to be a popular recreational activity. From coast to coast, and everywhere in between people are taking to the water and enjoying time together boating, sailing, paddling and fishing. During National Safe Boating Week, the U.S. Coast Guard and its federal, state and local safe boating partners encourage all boaters to explore and enjoy America's beautiful waters responsibly.

Safe boating begins with preparation. The Coast Guard estimates that human error accounts for 70 percent of all boating accidents and that life jackets could prevent nearly 85 percent of boating

fatalities. Through basic boating safety procedures - carrying lifesaving emergency distress and communications equipment, wearing life jackets, attending safe boating courses, participating in free boat safety checks, and staying sober when navigating - we can help ensure boaters on America's coastal inland, and offshore waters stay safe throughout the season.

The Perdido Bay Power Squadron, Inc. has requested that the Baldwin County Commission proclaim the week of May 18-24, 2019, "National Safe Boating Week" in Baldwin County, Alabama to encourage safe boating practices, as well as to encourage boaters to use life preservers, during this year's boating season.
