 Alabama 200. A curriculum was created that is now being used in fourth and tenth grade
 classrooms on local history. All of Baldwin County's projects was planned to last beyond the
 Bicentennial Celebration. Our projects are educational investments that will repay decades
 forward.

The committee reached out to other municipalities and organizations throughout the county and encouraged them to join the celebration. Baldwin County is represented by having twelve of its fifteen municipalities participating in the celebration.
