Request to Use Byrnes Lake Landing and the Bicentennial Park Grounds for Overnight Camping and a Movie Screening Event "On Set Cinema"

# STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The County Administrator has received a request from Mr. Kenny Caperton from Hillsborough, North Carolina (**see attached email request**), for the following:

1) Utilize the County-owned Byrnes Lake Landing site for a movie screening event, "On Set Cinema," on November 12, 2021, and November 13, 2021, for approximately three (3) hours after sunset; and

2) The use of Bicentennial Park grounds for overnight camping and an additional movie viewing event November 12, 2021, and November 13, 2021.

Mr. Caperton operates a project, "On Set Cinema," where movies are shown all over the country at their actual filming locations. Byrnes Lake Landing was one of the filming sites for the movie "Friday the 13<sup>th"</sup> and Mr. Caperton is hoping to hold the event at Byrnes Lake Landing for that reason.

The event would be a for-profit event with a maximum of 50 people attending who would buy tickets from Mr. Caperton to participate.

Approval of the request is contingent upon Mr. Caperton providing the County with a certificate of liability insurance that meets County requirements prior to the event taking place. If approved, Mr.

Caperton has a standard facility agreement used for these events which would be included in the resulting agenda action item along with the certificate of liability insurance.
