ITEM TITLE

Intergovernmental Service Agreement between Baldwin County and the City of Orange Beach for Routine Maintenance of Navy Road in Orange Beach City Limits

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Approve an Intergovernmental Service Agreement between the Baldwin County Commission and the City of Orange Beach for Area 300 Maintenance Crews to perform routine blading on Navy Road (1.00 mile) that lies within Orange Beach city limits for a period of twenty-four (24) months. The City of Orange Beach will be billed quarterly for the actual cost of the work performed. (*This agreement shall be effective upon full execution and terminate after twenty-four (24) months, unless terminated by either party upon the delivery of a thirty (30) day notice of termination.*)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Previous Commission action/date: March 6, 2018 - The Commission approved an Intergovernmental Service Agreement with the City of Orange Beach for Area 300 to perform routine blading on Navy Road (1.00 mile) that lies within Orange Beach city limits for a period of twenty-four (24) months.
